

COOKIE POLICY

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1. This Cookie Policy explains how Mirage Roleplay uses cookies and similar browser-storage technologies in connection with gta5mirage.com and the Mirage Forum.

1.2. Similar technologies may include Local Storage, Session Storage, authentication tokens, and other browser-based storage mechanisms.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

2.1. Cookies are small pieces of information stored on or accessed from a user's device when visiting a website. They may be used to maintain sessions, remember settings, provide security functions, and store consent choices.

3. HOW MIRAGE USES COOKIES AND LOCAL STORAGE

3.1. Mirage may use cookies and similar technologies for account authentication, maintaining Forum login sessions, security, session management, language preferences, privacy choices, and technically necessary website functionality.

3.2. Mirage does not currently use its own Google Analytics or comparable advertising/marketing tracking system.

3.3. Browser storage used by the Forum may contain authentication/session information. Passwords themselves are not intentionally stored in readable plain text by Mirage; account passwords are stored server-side only as hashes.

4. STRICTLY NECESSARY TECHNOLOGIES

4.1. Strictly necessary cookies or storage technologies may be required for authentication, login persistence, account security, abuse prevention, language settings, and storage of privacy choices.

4.2. Where such storage is technically required to provide a service requested by the user, it may remain active even when optional technologies are rejected.

5. AUTHENTICATION AND SESSION STORAGE

5.1. Mirage Forum authentication may store session or authentication information in the user's browser. This allows a user to remain logged in after leaving or closing the website.

5.2. Deleting Mirage website data through the browser may remove authentication information and require a new login.

5.3. Supabase is used as part of the Mirage Forum authentication and backend infrastructure.

6. LANGUAGE AND COOKIE PREFERENCES

6.1. Mirage may locally store the selected language and the user's cookie/privacy decision so these preferences do not need to be selected repeatedly.

7. OPTIONAL TECHNOLOGIES

7.1. If Mirage introduces optional analytics, statistics, personalization, advertising, or similar technologies in the future, they will be classified appropriately and, where legally required, will not be activated before consent.

8. COOKIE CONSENT INTERFACE

8.1. Mirage may provide a cookie/privacy interface containing options such as ACCEPT ALL, NECESSARY ONLY, and SETTINGS.

8.2. Strictly necessary technologies may remain active where required for core functionality, security, authentication, or a service expressly requested by the user.

9. THIRD-PARTY INFRASTRUCTURE

9.1. Vercel Vercel is used to host and deliver the Mirage website and Forum.

9.2. Cloudflare Cloudflare is used for domain, network, and security functionality.

9.3. Supabase Supabase is used for Forum database and authentication functionality.

9.4. These infrastructure providers may process technically necessary connection information, including IP addresses, when users connect. This network-level processing is separate from Mirage's own persistent game-account or security IP records, which Mirage stores in encrypted form.

10. IP ADDRESSES AND COOKIES

10.1. Mirage does not use cookies for the purpose of storing a readable persistent IP address in the user's browser.

10.2. Where Mirage intentionally stores an IP address in its own account or security database, that stored Mirage record is encrypted. An IP address may nevertheless be technically processed by hosting or network providers when a connection is established.

11. SOCIAL MEDIA AND EXTERNAL LINKS

11.1. Mirage may provide ordinary links to Discord, YouTube, and TikTok. Mirage does not currently automatically load embedded Discord, YouTube, or TikTok widgets solely because the relevant link is displayed.

11.2. When a user follows an external link, the respective third party may use its own cookies and technologies under its own policies.

12. FONTS

12.1. Fonts used on the Mirage website are intended to be hosted locally. Locally hosted fonts do not require an automatic request to Google Fonts when the page is displayed.

13. WITHDRAWING CONSENT

13.1. Consent for optional technologies may be withdrawn at any time with effect for the future. Mirage may provide a permanent option to reopen privacy or cookie settings.

13.2. Users may also remove cookies, Local Storage, and other website data through their browser. Removing authentication information may log the user out of the Forum.

14. MANAGING WEBSITE DATA THROUGH THE BROWSER

14.1. Most browsers allow users to view, delete, block, or restrict cookies and other website data. Blocking strictly necessary storage may cause parts of the Mirage website or Forum to stop functioning correctly.

15. CHANGES TO THIS COOKIE POLICY

15.1. Mirage may update this Cookie Policy when new technologies, providers, features, or legal requirements are introduced. The current version will be made available through the Mirage website.
